The Science and Mathematics faculties at Samaritan College are committed to encouraging and inspiring innovative and creative thinking in our students. UniSA share this vision with us, and it is through their Connect programs that they seek to do so. This term, UniSA are offering our Year 10 students the opportunity to take part in a day-long series of workshops focused on Networks and 3D Printing. The programs themselves will seek to develop student understanding and skill in concepts associated with networks in contexts that are varied and engaging, including the control of infectious disease, and train scheduling to prevent grid lock. Students will also have the opportunity to learn about CAD programming and the 3D printing process, and will be able to design and print their own keychain on the day. The sessions will run at UniSA's Whyalla campus and will be at no cost to students.

The sessions are scheduled as shown below:

10 Blue (Mr Elhalawani): Tuesday 1st August (Term 3, Week 2)

10 Red (Mr O'Connor): Tuesday 1st August (Term 3, Week 2)

10 Gold (Mr Nodoro): Wednesday 2nd August (Term 3, Week 2)

Students will walk to the university and back with their class teachers, Mr Adel Elhalawani, Mr Michael O'Connor and Mr Tariro Nodoro, departing at the start of Lesson 1 and returning during Lesson 7. In order to adhere to WHS guidelines here and within UniSA's classrooms, students must be in P.E. uniform on the day, with their appropriate enclosed footwear and hair held back from their faces. Students should take with them their recess and lunch, as well as a refillable drink bottle.
