For Year 7-10 Mathematics

Preferred model (these are called 'scientific' calculators):



Texas Instruments TI-30XB MultiView

(or similar models from reputable brands i.e. Casio, Sharp, HP etc)

Whilst mobile phones and laptops do have the ability to be scientific calculators, it makes it far harder for the teacher if they have also have teach how to use the non-recommended models.

For Year 11 & 12 (Stage 1 & 2)

Graphic Calculators are needed for Specialist Maths, Mathematical Methods and General Maths in Year 11 and 12. Essential Maths students can use the Year 7-10 model in Year 11 but must have the model below for Year 12. This model is what Samaritan senior students **should** use (there are very limited alternatives if you do not use this model).
